1) PARTICULAS QUE UNEN DOS FRASES



WHO / THAT

Que - Para personas (who)

- Ex: “The girl who / that lives next door works in BBVA.”
- “I have many students who / that live in the south of Madrid.”



WHICH / THAT

Que - Para cosas & animales

- Ex: “My neighbour’s dog which / that is a puppy is a German Shepperd.”
- Ex: “My car which I bought 3 years ago is a Peugeot.”

1) PARTICULAS QUE UNEN DOS FRASES



WHOSE

Cuyo / Cuya - Expresa posesion

- Ex: "My daughter's friend whose father was ill is already at home."
- Ex: "My teacher whose friend I know lives in Paris."
- Ex: "I just saw the colleague whose car broke down."



WHEN

Cuando - Se refiere a un momento

- Ex: "I remember the day when I started to work."

1) PARTICULAS QUE UNEN DOS FRASES



WHERE

Donde - Se refiere a un lugar

- Ex: "Sevilla is the city where I met my husband."
- Ex: "La Moraleja is a place where many famous people own a house."



2) CUANDO LA FRASE QUE AÑADE INFORMACIÓN VA ENTRE COMAS

NO es sustituible por THAT

**Quando haya coma sólo
WHO or WHICH.**

- “The girl, who lives next door, works in BBVA”
- “My neighbour’s dog, which is a puppy, is a German Shepperd.
- “My car, which I bought 3 years ago, is a Peugeot.

WHO / WHICH / THAT se pueden omitir cuando NO son el sujeto de la frase relativo.

(la que añade información).

- “The house that I bought will rise in value in two years.”
- “That is the restaurant which I like so much”
- “Why don’t you go on holidays with people WHO share your interests?”
